Programme Details

This innovative programme is grounded in the latest research into effective professional development (PD) and reflects the thinking behind the Standard for Teachers' Professional Development. It will challenge your thinking about the leadership of professional learning within your school and across schools. It will help you to evaluate the impact of PD on teacher effectiveness and student outcomes, and it will suggest ways in which you can adapt your practice.

The programme will explore 4 key questions:

- PD leadership: Whose role is it?
- Effective PD: What works?
- Organisational change: How is PD supported?
- Impact of PD: How do we know it is making a difference?

- How do we make sure we share and improve teacher practice?
- How can we develop our own understanding of effective PD?

Session 3

Organisational change - How is PD supported so that it makes a difference?

- How can you link PD to improvements in student outcomes?
- How do we know if PD is having any impact?
- How do you identify and nurture talent in your organisation?
- How can you harness potential through coaching?
